RESCUE MINISTRIES OF MEXICO

Rescue Ministries of Mexico is a non-profit organization conforming under the IRS code: USA 501 C(3).

Founded in 1988 by our Pastor Guadalupe Varela de Páez as a Christian organization, we were established as Vino, Trigo y Aceite in Ciudad Juarez, Chih., Mexico. For over 25 years, Vino, Trigo y Aceite has worked to provide shelter, food and love to children, adolescents, adults and seniors in key cities of northern Mexico such as: Ciudad Juarez, Chihuahua, Ciudad Madera and El Largo Maderal in Chihuahua and in the city of Gomez Palacio in the State of Durango.



VINO, TRIGO Y ACEITE

Located in the city of Juarez, this is the main church and headquarters of our organization. For over 25 years, we have served the inner city neighborhoods of Ciudad Juarez, where crime, drugs and the total disintegration of family values are rampant.



Through our "Feeding the Children" program, we have been able to make a positive impact in our society. Our "Feeding the Children" program attracts children and other family members, who are encouraged to participate in the dynamic biblical teachings presented by our volunteers. Our goal is to keep our young people from drugs, gangs and other destructive influences in our community.

FOOD BANK AND MORE

Up to now, and through God's provision, our ministry has been able to furnish the needs of the shelters, the outreach programs and of our affiliated churches. Our food bank is set up to help people in need of clothing, wheelchairs, food and other special needs. We also provide "care baskets" for families in impoverished condition.

ORPHANAGE IN CD. JUAREZ

At this location, we provide a home for orphans and for abused, neglected, at risk or abandoned children. Most of our children are referred to us by government institutions and by family members, who having no other place to take them, find within our facilities, the care they need.

TEEN HOME IN CD. JUAREZ

There is a well known fact that the gunmen responsible for most of the killings in the city of Juarez, are less than 21 years old. This at-risk population is our target. We work with young men who are fighting drug addictions, who have been victims of sexual or commercial exploitation or who have been abandoned by their families. We have tried to build a “home” atmosphere, where these young people are cared for with love, disciple and respect.

EXTRA-CURRICULUM ACTIVITIES

Children and the teenagers receive:

- Music & singing lessons
- Cooking & baking lessons
- Computer training
- English classes

Through ICATECH, teenagers also receive training on:

- Carpentry
- Hydroponic and greenhouse care
- Animal husbandry (stockbreeding)
- And farming

SIDEWALK CHURCH

We know some people don't like the formal setting of a church. By holding outdoor church services during the summer months, we are able to take the gospel straight to their doors.

GRANJA HOGAR DE NIÑOS CIUDAD MADERA, CHIH.

The city of Madera is a small town, that sets up against the Sierra of Chihuahua, MX. Our ministry in Ciudad Madera, offers a wide array of opportunities for missionary work within a nature setting. We work mainly with indigenous children from the Tarahumara and Pima tribes. Most of these children have been exposed to drugs, abuse and/or extreme poverty. They are placed with us by government institutions, family members, acquaintances or they arrive on their own due to extreme poverty or abandonment.

MEN'S RESCUE MISSION

We work with men who are being rehabilitated from drugs or alcohol. As the situation arises, we also care for elderly and disabled people that are referred to our organization.

A HOME FOR THE ELDERLY

Located in the beautiful mountains of Madera, we care for the elderly, an extremely neglected group in Mexico. They receive physical and medical attention, as well as spiritual support.

MEDICAL CLINIC

At the home for the elderly in Madera, we made arrangements for a medical clinic to be opened. They also give free medical and dental assistance to the town people.
